

Limassol Excursion

Our excursion will begin from the venue Hotel - The Royal Apollonia, at 10:00 am. We will start our 40 minute guided drive to Kourion in air-conditioned buses. The archaeological remains of Kourion are one of the island's most important antiquities. Excavations have unearthed many significant findings.. The city-kingdom was built on the hills of the area, overlooking the valley of the river Kouris. The once-flourishing kingdom was eventually destroyed in a severe earthquake in 365 AD.



At the site we will see the magnificent Greco-Roman theatre, the site's centrepiece, which was built in the 2nd century BC. Participants will also have the opportunity to view beautiful 5th century mosaics and impressive public baths and the remains of an early Christian basilica and the Roman Agora which dates back to the early 3rd century!



The tour will then take us to the Limassol Medieval Castle, which is where Richard the Lionheart married Berengaria of Navarre and crowned her Queen of England in 1191. The castle is situated in the heart of Limassol's old town, where participants will have a bit of free time for shopping and then try the delicious Cypriot, traditional, street food. After lunch and a short stroll in the new Limassol Marina, we will start making our way back to the hotel, which we will reach by 14:30.
