## **RIEDEL - THE WINEGLASS COMPANY**

Visitors can experience how the talented glassmakers produce a drinking glass or a decanter from a gallery in the heart of the Tyrolean glassworks. Precision and finesse are important, because each piece is one of a kind.

The Riedel Museum and the "Glass Cabinet - Retrospective & ideas laboratory" at the Kufstein site show a comprehensive depiction of the work of the Riedel glassmaking family in Kufstein from 1957 onwards, presenting highlights of the family's history and glass art in Bohemia. The glassmaking museum features an interactive and family-friendly portrayal of the craft all the way to the physics and chemistry of glass production.

The "Sinnfonie" multimedia show of emotions takes you on a journey through the five sensory perceptions and immerses you in our world of glass and the senses. Seeing, hearing, smelling, feeling, tasting in the harmonious interplay of glass and wine.

The exhibition area conveys an insight into the history of glass production from its beginnings through to the present day, glass production, quality control, as well as the work and life of the glassmakers.

You will get an exclusive insight into the factory from the Glassmaking Museum. Following an informative and interactive introduction to glassmaking and the history of the craft, plus an overview of Riedel's production sites, you will experience up close how glasses are handmade using wooden and metal tools.
